FROM THE PASTOR

THE WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHURCH UNITY begins this Saturday, Jan. 18, and concludes on Jan. 25 – eight days. According to Wikipedia the dates of the week were proposed by Father Paul Wattson, cofounder of the Graymoor Franciscan Friars. He conceived of the week beginning on the ancient Feast of the Chair of Saint Peter, on Jan. 18, and concluding with the Feast of the Conversion of Saint Paul on Jan. 25. Pope St. Pius X officially blessed the concept, and Pope Benedict XV encouraged its observance throughout the entire Roman Catholic Church.

When we pray for Christian unity, what is it exactly that we are praying for? We are praying that all Christians be once again united under the leadership of the Pope in the Catholic Church. We are praying that all Christians fully embrace the Catholic faith (that includes many dissident Catholics). Let us be sure to include this important intention in our daily praying of the Rosary during this octave.*

*Footnote: Not only should we pray for the conversion of non-Catholic Christians, we should pray for the conversion of everyone: Jews, Muslims, Hindus, Buddhists, Mormons, Jehovah Witnesses, New Agers, Agnostics, Atheists and anyone else who is not Catholic. Since the Catholic Church is the one, true Church founded by God Himself for the salvation of mankind, in charity, we are obliged to pray for them.

LA SEMANA DE ORACIÓN POR LA UNIDAD DE LOS CRISTIANOS comienza este sábado, 18 de enero, y concluye el 25 de enero - ocho días. Según Wikipedia, las fechas de la semana fueron propuestas por el padre Paul Wattson, cofundador de los frailes franciscanos de Graymoor. Él concibió la semana comenzando en la antigua Fiesta de la Cátedra de San Pedro, el 18 de enero, y concluyendo con la Fiesta de la Conversión de San Pablo el 25 de enero. El Papa San Pío X bendijo oficialmente el concepto y el Papa Benedicto XV animó a que se observara en toda la Iglesia Católica Romana.

Cuando oramos por la unidad de los cristianos, ¿qué es exactamente por lo que estamos orando? Estamos orando para que todos los cristianos estén nuevamente unidos bajo el liderazgo del Papa en la Iglesia Católica. Estamos orando para que todos los cristianos abracen plenamente la fe católica (que incluye a muchos católicos disidentes). Asegurémonos de incluir esta importante intención en nuestro rezo diario del Rosario durante esta octava*.

*Nota: No sólo debemos orar por la conversión de los cristianos no católicos, sino por la conversión de todos: Judíos, musulmanes, hindúes, budistas, mormones, testigos de Jehová, de la Nueva Era, agnósticos, ateos y cualquier otro que no sea católico. Puesto que la Iglesia Católica es la única y verdadera Iglesia fundada por Dios mismo para la salvación de la humanidad, en la caridad, estamos obligados a orar por ellos.
