FROM THE PASTOR

This Wednesday, Feb. 26, is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lent. There's an old saying: "Well begun is half done." Let's get off to a good start by going to Mass this Wednesday, receiving ashes, and (for those of whom it is required) fasting and abstaining from eating meat. We know from experience just how quickly Lent passes. Let's not waste this holy season of Lent by doing little or nothing. There are three areas to which we want to apply ourselves throughout Lent: prayer, fasting, and alms giving.

Prayer: The best prayer of all is the Mass; come daily, or, as often as you can during Lent. It's to be hoped that everyone will make a good confession during this season. Making the Stations of the Cross is especially recommended during this time of year (they will be prayed at 6 p.m. before Mass every Friday of Lent).

Fasting: Fasting from food is one of the oldest of religious practices. It both takes weight off our bodies, and adds weight to our prayers. Some people fast throughout Lent; others will do so two or three times a week; some give up eating between meals; and still others abstain from something they like to eat or drink (for example, sweets). Not only can we fast from food, we can "fast" from other things, for example, giving up recreational electronic use. **Alms giving:** This can best be done by practicing both the corporal and spiritual works of mercy. Don't forget to start with the people in your own family. Have a blessed Lent!

DEL PÁRROCO

Este miércoles, 26 de febrero es Miércoles de Ceniza, el comienzo de la Cuaresma. Hay un viejo dicho: "Lo que bien comienza, bien acaba". Empecemos bien por yendo a misa este miércoles, recibir cenizas, y (para aquellos que lo requieran) ayunar y abstenerse de comer carne. Sabemos por experiencia lo rápido que pasa la Cuaresma. No desperdiciemos esta santa temporada de Cuaresma haciendo poco o nada. Hay tres áreas a las que queremos aplicarnos durante la Cuaresma: la oración, el ayuno y la limosna. **La oración:** La mejor oración de todas es la Misa; venir diariamente, o, tan a menudo como podamos durante la Cuaresma. Es de esperar que todos hagan una buena confesión durante esta época. Se recomienda especialmente hacer el Vía Crucis en esta época del año (se rezará a las 6 pm antes de la misa, todos los viernes de Cuaresma). **Ayuno:** El ayuno de la comida es una de las prácticas religiosas más antiguas. Nos quita peso corporal y añade peso a nuestras oraciones. Algunas personas ayunan durante toda la Cuaresma; otras lo hacen dos o tres veces por semana; algunas dejan de comer entre comidas; y otras se abstienen de algo que les gusta comer o beber (por ejemplo, dulces). No sólo podemos ayunar de la comida, sino que también podemos "ayunar" de otras cosas, por ejemplo, renunciar al uso recreativo de lo electrónico.

Dar limosna: La mejor manera de hacerlo es practicando las obras de misericordia tanto corporales como espirituales. No olvide comenzar con las personas de su propia familia. ¡Que tengan una bendita Cuaresma!
