- Confessions are still being heard Monday – Saturday, from 7 – 9 a.m., and from 5 – 6:30 p.m. **Note:** These times will vary during the Sacred Triduum
- Now that we've begun live streaming the Mass, the church is closed from 9 – 10 a.m., Monday – Saturday; and from 9 – 10:30 a.m. on Sundays. **Note:** These times will vary during the Sacred Triduum

HOLY WEEK SCHEDULE:

Palm Sunday: The blessing of palms will take place at the 9 a.m. live streamed Mass. The palms will be available for pick up throughout Holy Week beginning on Monday. Palms will be made available both in the church and in the courtyard. One palm per person.

- Confessions from 7 – 8:30 a.m., and 5 – 6:30 p.m.

Holy Thursday: Mass will be live streamed at 7 p.m.

- Confessions from 7 – 9 a.m.; and from 5 – 6:30 p.m.

Good Friday: Day of fast and abstinence. The service will be live streamed at 3 p.m.

- Confessions from 7 – 9 a.m.; and from 1 – 2:30 p.m.

Holy Saturday: Confessions from 7 – 9 a.m.; and 5 – 6:30 p.m.

- The Easter Vigil service will be live streamed. We will begin the service in the courtyard at 10:30 p.m., however, we will not enter the church until about 10:50 p.m. If you're following the live stream, you can tune in at about that time. We should finish around 1:30 a.m.

Easter: The live streamed Mass will be at 9 a.m. No scheduled confessions.

NOTE: The church will be closed during all live streaming events.

HORARIO DE SEMANA SANTA:

Jueves Santo: La misa será transmitida en vivo a las 7 p.m.

- Confesiones de 7-9 a.m. y 5-6:30 p.m.

Viernes Santo: Día de ayuno y abstinencia. El servicio será transmitido en vivo a las 3 p.m.

- Confesiones de 7-9 a.m. y 1-2:30 p.m.

Sábado Santo: Confesiones de 7-9 a.m. y 5-6:30 p.m.

- El servicio de la Vigilia Pascual será transmitido en vivo. Comenzaremos el servicio en el patio a las 10:30 p.m., sin embargo, no entraremos a la iglesia hasta aproximadamente las 10:50 p.m. Si están siguiendo la transmisión en vivo, pueden sintonizarla aproximadamente a esa hora. Deberíamos terminar alrededor de la 1:30 a.m.

Pascua: La misa en vivo será a las 9 a.m. No hay confesiones programadas.

NOTA: La iglesia estará cerrada durante todos los eventos de transmisión en vivo.

FROM THE PASTOR

Holy Week begins today with Palm Sunday. It is the holiest time of the liturgical year. During this week we celebrate the redemptive work of Christ – His Passion, Death, and Resurrection. In order to help you to profit spiritually from this week, find below some suggestions:

1. If you haven't yet gone to confession this Lent, and are able to do so, do it. Even if you are not conscious of having committed any mortal sins since your last good confession, a well-made confession will better dispose you to receive the graces Our Lord wants to give you at this time.
2. Even though it's not possible to attend Mass in church and receive Holy Communion, you can follow the Mass online and make a Spiritual Communion
3. If you have been negligent in keeping your Lenten resolutions, make an extra effort to keep them this week.
4. Keep electronic entertainment to a minimum – internet, TV, video games, etc.
5. Do a little fasting, and/or abstain from some favorite food. **Note:** Good Friday is a day of fasting for those between the ages of 18 and the completion of their 59th birthday. Abstinence from meat is obligatory on that day for all of those 14 and older.
6. Do practice religious devotions: make the Stations of the Cross (if you can't do it in church, do it at home), meditate especially on the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary, pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, read the story of the Passion of Our Lord from any one of the Gospels, read the liturgy of the day from your missal, etc.
7. Practice greater kindness and patience with the people you live with and work with. Good deeds and acts of charity are always in order. Try to be mindful of the poor in some concrete way.

This period of quarantine provides us all with more opportunities to practice patience; to carry the cross. Let us remember that whatever hardship the COVID 19 virus places upon us, it cannot separate us from the love of Christ. St. Paul tells us in Romans 8: ³⁵Who then shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation? or distress? or famine? or nakedness? or danger? or persecution? or the sword? ³⁷But in all these things we overcome, because of Him who has loved us.

(extract from the Roman Ritual, Titulus IX, Caput X)

- V. Deal not with us, Lord, according to our sins.
 R. And take not vengeance on us because of our misdeeds.
 V. Help us, O God, our Deliverer.
 R. And for thy name's sake, O Lord, free us.
 V. Remember not, O Lord, our sins of old.
 R. Hasten to us with thy compassion, for we are become exceedingly poor.
 V. St. Sebastian, pray for us.
 R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.
 V. O Lord, hear my prayer.
 R. And let my cry come unto thee.
 V. The Lord be with you.
 R. And with thy spirit
 Let us pray.

Vouchsafe to hear us, O God, our only salvation! And through the intercession of the glorious and blessed Mary, Mother of God and ever Virgin, of thy blessed martyr, Sebastian and of all the saints, deliver thy people from the terrors of thy wrath, and restore their confidence by the outpouring of thy compassion.

Be moved to pity, O Lord, at our earnest entreaties, and heal the illnesses of body and soul; so that experiencing thy forgiveness we may ever rejoice in thy blessing.

We beseech thee, O Lord, grant us a hearing as we devoutly raise our petitions to thee, and graciously turn away the epidemic of plague which afflicts us; so that mortal hearts may recognize that these scourges proceed from thine indignation and cease only when thou art moved to mercy.
