54 DAY ROSARY FOR THE TRIUMPH OF THE IMMACULATE HEART: We invite all members and supporters of FSSP apostolates in the USA to participate as we specially petition and give thanks to the Blessed Virgin during this time of pandemic, riots, political and social unrest, and the scandals and loss of faith within the Church.

To participate, visit <https://fssp.com/54-day-rosary/> and print out the [54 Day Instruction](#) and the [54 Day – Assumption](#), then pray the rosary and special prayers as indicated each day starting on July 19th.

And please distribute this announcement far and wide so that as many people as possible can support this effort of prayer for the Church and the nation.

NEW PRIESTS: In case you missed the announcement... Fr. Mahowald and Fr. Dorsa have been transferred to apostolates in Florida. The two new priests are Fr. Earl Eggleston and Fr. Joseph Loftus. Please make them feel welcome.

MASS LIMITATIONS: Even though Mass is now open to the public, it doesn't mean that all who want to come to Mass will be able to do so. Even with the addition of another Sunday Mass we'll still only be able to accommodate about 1/3rd of all the people who normally come here. For this reason, in the interest of fairness, you will have the opportunity to sign up once every three weeks. Sign-ups will be determined on the basis of the first letter of your last name. Sunday Mass reservations by last name:

1. **A-G** Sun., July 12; sign up on Mon., July 6 @ 1 pm
2. **H-P** Sun., July 19; sign up on Mon., July 13 @ 1 pm
3. **Q-Z** Sun., July 26; sign up on Mon., June 20 @ 1 pm

Note: If you have not checked in before the beginning of mass your seat may be given to someone else. When the "social distancing" rules change we will be able to allow more people to come to the Mass. Please pray that that day comes soon.

SANITIZING THE CHURCH: Please consider staying after Mass for about 10 -15 minutes to sanitize the church. The goal is to sanitize all surfaces daily that are touched by hands: i.g. tops of pews, all door handles, etc. Supplies and instructions are provided and are located in a clear box in one of the confessionals.

LIVE MASS STREAMING: We will continue to live stream the Mass daily at 9 a.m.

LIMITACIONES DE LA MISA: Aunque la misa ya esté abierta al público, no significa que todos los que quieran acudir a Misa lo podrán hacer. Aún con la adición de otra Misa Dominical sólo podremos acomodar un tercio de la gente que normalmente asiste a Misa. Para ser justos lo más posible, tendrá la oportunidad de anotarse para la Misas una vez cada tres semanas. Las reservaciones serán determinadas por orden alfabético por el apellido de la familia.

Cuando las reglas del "distanciamiento social" cambien, podremos permitir que más gente acuda a Misa. Por favor, recé para que pronto llegue ese día.

DESINFECTAR LA IGLESIA: Por favor, considere a quedarse después de Misa unos 10 o 15 minutos para desinfectar la iglesia. El objetivo es desinfectar todas las superficies que se tocan con las manos diariamente: es decir, la parte superior de los bancos, todas las manijas de las puertas, etc. Los productos de limpieza y las instrucciones se proporcionaran y se encuentran en una caja transparente en unos de los confesionarios.

PLEASE DRESS MODESTLY It is a good time for a reminder on modest attire. While at the church, everyone is expected to dress modestly. Here are some guidelines:

- Dresses and skirts should be long enough that the knees are covered when sitting.
- Shoulders should be covered.
- Necklines should not be revealing.
- Clothing should not be too tight. Clothing is to conceal, not reveal.
- Shorts are not suitable wear for church.

These are the rules for dressing at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. Please follow them when at St. Anne's. When you dress for church, dress to please Our Lord.

Finally: We do request that the correction of visitors in this matter be left to the priests or their delegates.
