THE BAPTISM OF OUR LORD

Editor's note: This Saturday, January 13th, we celebrate the Baptism of Our Lord. It's a good day to come to Mass to celebrate our own baptism, to reflect upon its meaning, and to ask ourselves how well we are fulfilling our baptismal promises. You might want to test your knowledge of baptism with the following quiz:
